- Remember this is Jeopardy, so where I have written “Answer” this is the prompt the students will see, and where I have “Question” should be the student’s response.
- To enter your questions and answers, click once on the text on the slide, then highlight and just type over what’s there to replace it. If you hit Delete or Backspace, it sometimes makes the text box disappear.
- When clicking on the slide to move to the next appropriate slide, be sure you see the hand, not the arrow. *(If you put your cursor over a text box, it will be an arrow and WILL NOT take you to the right location.)*

**This Northern Colorado city
got its beginning in 1862
when a contingent of soldiers
was based here to protect the
Cherokee trail and to guard
the Overland Stage Line.**

**What is Fort
Collins?**

**Author James Michener
lived here when he attended
Colorado State College of
Education.**

What is Greeley?

**This Northern Colorado town
was twice the county seat of
government in Weld County
before night-riders from
Greeley stole the records and
burned the courthouse.**

**What is the town of
Evans?**

**This common form of Northern
Colorado municipal government
has a council balanced by an
executive.**

**What is the
Manager-Council
Form of
Government?**

**An ordinance dealing with
this issue was approved in the
City of Fort Collins but
recently voted down in the
City of Greeley.**

**What are
backyard chickens?**

**This organization is federally
mandated and plans how to
spend state and federal
transportation dollars in
Larimer and Weld Counties.**

**What is the North Front
Range Metropolitan
Planning Organization
(NFRMPO)?**

**This organization advocates
for businesses in Northern
Colorado and is one of the
longest operating examples
of regional cooperation in
the area.**

**What is the Northern
Colorado Legislative
Alliance (NCLA)?**

**This area typically
encompasses the Northern
Colorado region.**

**What are Larimer and
Weld Counties?**

A planning organization in the Denver area that includes Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Clear Creek, Douglas, Gilpin and Jefferson counties, plus the City of and County of Denver, the City and County of Broomfield and southwest Weld County.

**What is the Denver
Regional Council of
Governments
(DRCOG)?**

This regional public agency was created in 1937 primarily to contract with the United States to build the Colorado Big Thompson Project. Today, it provides for agricultural, municipal, domestic and industrial uses in northeastern Colorado.

**What is the Northern Colorado
Water Conservancy District
(NCWCD)?**

**This Northern Colorado
county has a reputation for
being somewhat liberal, but
has 12,944 more registered
Republicans than Democrats**

What is Larimer County?

**This county officer is
responsible for
overseeing elections.**

**What is the County
Clerk?**

**This Northern
Colorado county
supported John
McCain in the last
presidential election.**

**Who is Weld
County?**

**There are seven of these
elected officials
representing Colorado
in Washington, D.C.**

**Who are the
Colorado U.S.
Representatives?**

**This group is the largest
political affiliation of
registered voters in
Colorado.**

Who are the unaffiliateds?

34.03% of total voters –
33.14% D; 32.84% R

**This state agency is
responsible for working
with local governments
in Colorado.**

**What is the
Department of
Local Affairs?**

**Colorado has 59 cities and
30 towns that have adopted
this form of governance
which gives them more
autonomy from the state.**
